### Notes:

1. In addition to the annual membership dues, all new members are charged a one-time initiation fee, a member service hours fee, and must attend the New Member Orientation meeting held by the Club Safety Committee prior to issuance of a membership card.
2. The work fee is charged each year, in addition to dues, until the member performs "service-hours". Once work-hours are completed, the annual work fee is no longer charged.
3. Senior membership is available to a regular member who joined the PF&G prior to March 22, 2005, who has reached the age 65, and who has been a regular member in good standing for the preceding 5 consecutive years, or anyone who was a member of the Canobie Fish and Game Club in 1989, and who has since 1989 remained a member of PF&G, and who has now reached the age of 62. Senior Members are not required to pay dues, but must pay fees.
