



2026 New Hampshire Highpower Rifle Clinic and Governor's 10 EIC

with

**National Rifle Champion Brandon Green
Saturday & Sunday, May 2-3 2026
Rain or Shine**



Description: Brandon Green, multi-time National Champion and the first American in history to win the King's Prize at Bisley UK, will be at Pelham Fish & Game on Saturday, the 2nd of May, 2026 to conduct an Advanced Highpower Rifle Clinic with both classroom and live fire instruction. Following the clinic (on Sunday), a CMP Service Rifle Excellence-in-Competition match will be conducted, with multiple relays on electronic targets. Cost for the clinic and EIC is \$150, which also covers lunch on both days. PF&G members save \$25 (\$125 for both clinic and EIC).

Range: Pelham Fish & Game 600 yard rifle range, utilizing ShotMarker Electronic Targets (no pit duty)

Directions to the Range: Enter "Pelham Fish & Game" into your preferred map app. Or for the old school: 96 Simpson Mill Road, Pelham, NH 03076 From points south: Rt. 93 North to exit 2. Make a right at the exit light. (*) Make a right at next light (South Policy). Make a right at next light (Lowell Rd). Follow for approx 3 miles. Make a right onto Hobbs Rd (you will see signs for Pelham Fish and Game). Make next right onto Simpson Mill Rd. PF&G is about ½ mile on the right. Once inside the gate (code provided to participants after registration), the clinic will start inside the clubhouse. From Points North: Rt. 93 South to exit 2. Make a right at end of exit ramp. Follow the same directions as above from (*) point.

Eligibility: Clinic is open to all safe shooters (members and non-members). Junior shooters (under 18 years old) must be accompanied by an adult.

Registration and Fees:

- A package fee of \$150.00 covers match fees, instructor fees, transportation and expenses, BBQ lunch for both Saturday and Sunday, and door prizes. It includes classroom instruction, hands-on live fire instruction on Saturday, and an EIC on Sunday.
- Firm reservations will be taken via cash (in person), check (made out to Pelham Fish & Game, sent to Matt Bartel, 58 Winnicutt Rd. Stratham NH 03885, Venmo (@fa18hooker), or Zelle (fa18hooker@hotmail.com, 603-459-4767). Please annotate "Green Clinic" and your email on your payment. Confirmation of your reservation will be sent to your included email. If you do not receive confirmation within 24 hours, email fa18hooker@hotmail.com with your information.
- You must include your current classification (NRA or CMP), as well as your current NMC average for squadding. This clinic is an advanced rifle clinic, but is appropriate for all shooters (i.e. we will have instructors for all levels of shooting ability, with an instructor to shooter ratio of 1:5 for lots of hands on coaching in addition to personal instruction from Brandon Green).

Advance registration is required to guarantee your squadding. A waiting list will be created after the first 50 registrants. No refunds, regardless of reason for cancellation. Clinic and match will be conducted rain or shine.

Food: Water is provided. Lunch is included in the match fees.

Start Time: Saturday, 2 May 2026, 0800 at the Main Clubhouse: Roll Call and overview, followed by gear review and classroom instruction. A 200 yard live fire clinic will be conducted Saturday afternoon. Sunday is a full NMC EIC, starting at 0800 in the clubhouse for registration and recap, with first shot at 0900. Expected finish time on Saturday is 1700, Sunday is 1500. NOTE: These times are approximate, and will change, arrive early. Those not seated by 0800 will lose their spot to a standby shooter. Attending the clinic obligates the shooter to fire the EIC matches (it is common courtesy to support your fellow shooters at an EIC match).

Rules: Current CMP Rules will govern as appropriate. Competitors are required to be familiar with the contents of the current rule book. An **Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required** in all CMP sanctioned pistol competitions to indicate that the bolt is open and the chamber is empty.

Classification: No classifications necessary for the EIC match. Top 10 percent of competitors achieving the minimum cutoff score will be awarded leg points.

Firearms: Service rifle with iron sights or optics no greater than 4.5x magnification. See CMP Highpower Rifle Rule Book (<https://online.fliphtml5.com/ebacv/rpgv/#p=1>) rule 5.1.1, 5.1.3 or 5.1.4 for legal service rifles.

Scoring: Electronic target scoring on ShotMarker targets. CMP rule 7.0 Electronic Target Scoring rules for specifics. A \$3.00 challenge fee will be paid for each challenge and refunded, if the challenge is upheld.

Targets: Standard highpower rifle targets will be used, but all scoring will be done via the electronic target system.

Alibis: Per current CMP rules, there will be no alibis during the EIC match. All sustained fire stages will start from the standing position.

Award Schedule: There will be no awards outside of the CMP EIC awards.
