

2025 New Hampshire Bullseye Pistol Clinic and EIC

with

National Pistol Champion Jim Henderson Saturday September 27th, 2025



Rain or Shine

Description: Jim Henderson, National Pistol Champion and current Director of Pistol Programs at the Civilian Marksmanship Program, will be at Pelham Fish & Game on Saturday, the 27th of September, 2025 to conduct a Bullseye Pistol Clinic with both classroom and live fire instruction. Following the clinic, 22 and Service Pistol CMP Excellence-in-Competition matches will be conducted, with an expected full line (50 shooters). Cost for the clinic and .22/SP EIC is \$130. Separate EIC-only registration is available for \$40. PF&G members save \$30 (\$100 for both clinic and EIC). A BBQ lunch is included in the fee.

Range: 50 yard slow fire; 25 yard timed & rapid fire on turning targets. 50 covered outdoor firing points.

Directions to the Range: Enter "Pelham Fish & Game" into your preferred map app. Or for the old school: 96 Simpson Mill Road, Pelham, NH 03076 From points south: Rt. 93 North to exit 2. Make a right at the exit light. (*) Make a right at next light (South Policy). Make a right at next light (Lowell Rd). Follow for approx 3 miles. Make a right onto Hobbs Rd (you will see signs for Pelham Fish and Game). Make next right onto Simpson Mill Rd. PF&G is about ½ mile on the right. Pistol range is located to left and rear of the main clubhouse. From Points North: Rt. 93 South to exit 2. Make a right at end of exit ramp. Follow the same directions as above from (*) point.

Eligibility: Clinic is open to all safe shooters (members and non-members) of all experience levels. Junior shooters (under 18 years old) must be accompanied by an adult.

Registration and Fees:

- A package fee of \$130.00 covers 2 EIC match fees (\$30), instructor fees, coaches transportation and expenses, BBQ lunch, door prizes and a t-shirt. It includes approximately 9 hours of classroom instruction, hands-on live fire instruction and .22/SP EIC matches (at the end of the day, we will run .22 and Service Pistol EIC 30-shot matches until everyone has fired).
- Firm reservations will be taken via cash (in person), check (made out to Pelham Fish & Game, sent to Matt Bartel, 58 Winnicutt Rd. Stratham NH 03885, Venmo (@fa18hooker), or Zelle (fa18hooker@hotmail.com, 603-459-4767). Please annotate "Henderson Clinic" on your payment, as well as your current classification and National Match Score average (i.e. "Henderson Clinic, Sharpshooter, 218 NMC). Confirmation of your reservation will be sent to your included email. If you do not receive confirmation within 24 hours, email fa18hooker@hotmail.com with your information.
- You must include your current classification (indoor or outdoor, NRA or CMP), as well as your current NMC average for squadding. This clinic is an advanced bullseye clinic, but is appropriate for all shooters (i.e. we will have instructors for all levels of shooting ability, with an instructor to shooter ratio of 1:5 for lots of hands on coaching in addition to personal instruction from Jim Henderson). We will squad by classification to ensure appropriate instruction for all shooters.

Advance registration is required to guarantee your squadding. A waiting list will be created after the first 50 registrants. No refunds, regardless of reason for cancellation. Clinic and match will be conducted rain or shine.

Food: Water is provided. Lunch is included in the match fees.

Start Time: 0800, Saturday, 27 September 2025 at the Main Clubhouse: Roll Call and overview, followed by gear review and movement to the turning target range where all shooters will fire a National Match Course (30 shots) to baseline current status. We will then go back to the clubhouse for extended classroom instruction and Q&A. At 1500, shooters will assume their firing point for a short live fire practice period, followed by EIC matches (until all shooters are complete). NOTE: These times are approximate, and will change, arrive early. Those not seated by 0800 will lose their spot to a standby shooter.

Attending the clinic obligates the shooter to fire the EIC matches (it is common courtesy to support your fellow shooters at an EIC match).

Rules: Current CMP Rules will govern as appropriate. Competitors are required to be familiar with the contents of the current rule book. An **Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI)** is required in all CMP sanctioned pistol competitions to indicate that the slide is open and the chamber is empty.

Classification: Current CMP or NRA classifications may be used. Those without a classification will be squadded based on the morning NMC.

Firearms: 22 caliber, and Service pistol per CMP Rules 5.1.2 (22) and 5.1.1 (SP). Triggers may be weighed, and **will** be weighed, if National Records are broken. Practice with any pistol (match or service), but the EIC matches must be shot with an approved pistol (iron sights, 2 pound (.22) or 4 pound trigger pull (SP)).

Scoring: Competitors will pass score cards to the right and score the competitor to the left, unless otherwise directed. Plugs and gauges will be used ONLY by designated range personnel. Competitors are responsible for repairing their own targets. Bring your own stapler, repair pasties/tape and small clipboard. A 3-man jury will be selected, if there is a challenge. A \$3.00 challenge fee will be paid for each challenge and refunded, if the challenge is upheld.

Targets: All slow fire will be on NRA B-6 50-yard slow fire targets. All timed and rapid fire will be on NRA B-8 25-yard targets. Targets and repair centers will be provided.

Award Schedule: There will be no awards outside of the CMP EIC awards.
